## NOTES FROM THE EDITOR

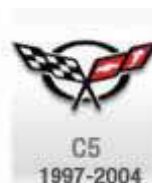

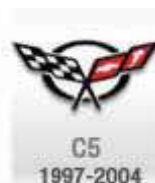

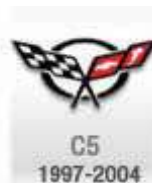
