*From the Editor*

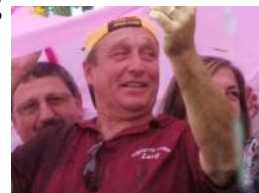
Greetings, and welcome to the October issue of Corvette Expressions.

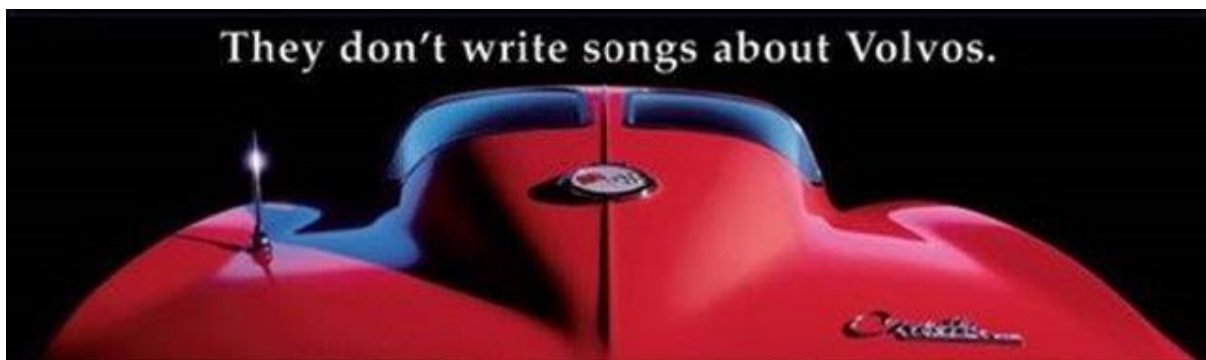

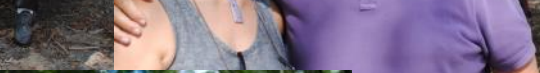

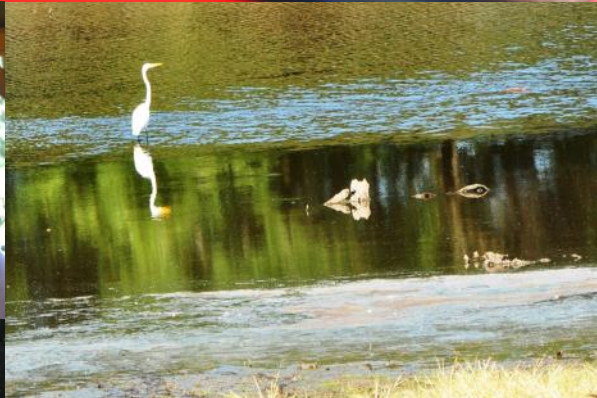


# Bombay Hook National Refuge and Maryland Crab House Cruise September 23
